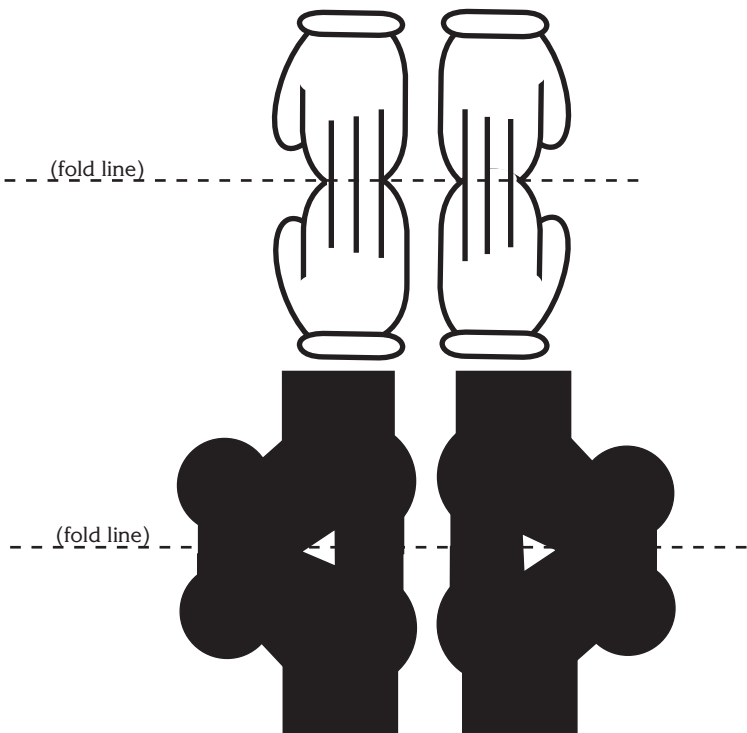


Hi! Dewey-the-Bookworm™ is my name,

- 1—Color Dewey as desired—pink & green stripes, rainbow, etc.
- 2—Cut out Dewey's body, gloves, and shoes.
- 3—Cut two pieces of 5 or 6 inch-long black yarn for his arms and legs.
- 4—Wipe glue thickly all over the *wrong* side of Dewey's body.
- 5—Place one yarn strip on glue across neck for arms, one across fold line for legs.
- 6—Fold Dewey in half, glue sides together, and press until firm.
- 7—Glue wrong sides of hands & feet, fold in half over yarn ends, press until firm.
- 8—Cover Dewey with a heavy book overnight, or until thoroughly dry.
- 9—Trim Dewey with scissors to even front and back edges, if necessary.

(Want *sparkly eyes*? Slit across lower eyelids, glue backs of two large black sequins, and insert halfway under lids!)
